Public Hearing on Streetlights  
September 21, 2011

A special meeting of the Henrietta Township board was called to order at 7:30 p.m. on September 21, 2011.

All members were present.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the Special Assessment Streetlight District. It was noted that the State of Michigan requires a public hearing and that is why this meeting was scheduled.

L. Bamm explained the streetlight district and noted the following:

1. The township received an audit of streetlights from Consumers Energy.
2. Township Assessor V. Bradley compared the audit from Consumers Energy to the list of parcels in the streetlight assessment district.
3. It was discovered that parcels in Munith had never been included in the streetlight assessment district.
4. Consumers Energy installed more efficient bulbs into the streetlights at no cost to the township.
5. L. Bamm drove the entire streetlight assessment district to confirm parcels were accurately assessed.
6. The township taxpayers will be responsible for 25% of the cost of streetlights. The streetlight assessment district will pay the remaining balance.

The township board then opened the hearing for public comment. Several residents spoke regarding streetlights.
