Henrietta Township Regulation of Traffic Ordinance #14

Adopted July 11, 1983 Effective Upon Publication

AN ORDINANCE FOR REGULATION OF TRAFFIC WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF HENRIETTA.

At a regular meeting of the Henrietta Township Board held on the 11th day of July, 1983, in the Henrietta Township Hall, the following Ordinance was heard and passed.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Township Board of the Township of Henrietta, County of Jackson, State of Michigan, as follows:

The Township of Henrietta hereby adopts by reference the Traffic Regulations set forth in Act 300 of the Public Acts of 1949, as amended, being the Michigan Motor Vehicle Code, and in particular all of the provisions of Act 514, Public Acts of 1978, and Act 309, Public Acts of 1982, for the regulation of traffic within the Township of Henrietta.

It further is ordained that the Township Clerk is directed and shall keep copies of the Michigan Motor Vehicle Code at the Township Office for inspection by and distribution to the public.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to adopt a code to regulate traffic within the Township, and to provide for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Township.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.

This Ordinance shall be published in the manner provided by law.
