AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE GARAGE AND YARD SALES

At a regular meeting of the township Board held in the Township Hall on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of July 1988, at 8:00 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, the following Ordinance was heard and passed:

THE TOWNSHIP OF HENRIETTA ORDAINS:

Occasional sales of household goods and personal property shall be permitted in each of the residential districts, but such occasional sales, whether they be designated as yard sales, garage sales, porch sales, moving sales, basement sales, or household or personal goods sales, shall not be held on any premises more often than once every ninety (90) days, and in no case shall any such sales exceed four (4) days in duration.

Signs advertising sales governed by this Ordinance shall not be posted for more than five (5) consecutive days either on the property where the sale is occurring or on any other property in the Township of Henrietta.

SECTION 1. PENALTIES

Pursuant to the adoption of Ordinance #37, effective February 28, 2002 any person, firm, corporation or other organization which violates, disobeys, omits, neglects, or refuses to comply with, any of the provisions of this Ordinance or amendments hereof, commits a municipal civil infraction punishable as follows:

**1<sup>st</sup>** offense – minimum of \$100.00 maximum of \$500.00 fine

**2<sup>nd</sup>** offense (within two years of first offense) minimum of \$200.00 maximum of \$500.00 fine

**3<sup>rd</sup>** offense (within two years of 2<sup>nd</sup> offense) minimum of \$300.00 maximum of \$500.00 fine

Each day that a violation occurs shall constitute a separate offense.

The court may order other relief relative to the infraction(s). This may include, but is not limited to, reimbursement of actual costs incurred by the Township to attain compliance of this ordinance.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after the earliest date allowed by law. This Ordinance shall be published in the manner provided by law.
