Henrietta Township Electrical Code Ordinance Ordinance #26

Adopted April 13, 1992 Effective May 5, 1992

An Ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Township of Henrietta under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act (Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.)

THE TOWNSHIP OF HENRIETTA ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. AGENCY DESIGNATED.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Michigan Electrical Code, in accordance with Act 230 of the public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Electrical Inspector of Henrietta Township is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of the Township of Henrietta under Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The Township of Henrietta assumes responsibilities for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout its corporate limits.

SECTION 2.

All Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3.

This Ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.
