

Henrietta Township's Transfer Station FAQ's

1. Does the Transfer Station accept brush and other lawn clippings?

Yes. However, that service is only for Henrietta residents and no commercial loads are allowed. It is free. It is preferred that it is not bagged, if it is bagged, it must be in a biodegradable bag.

2. Do you take cardboard?

Yes.

3. Do you take glass?

Yes.

4. Do you have to bag your recyclables in a clear bag?

No.

5. Are the woodchips at the County Road Commission free and when/how can I get them?

The road commission is open Mon-Thurs 6-4 and will require permission from them to get woodchips.

***The Transfer Station accepts almost all non-hazardous household waste. Paint unless it is completely dry, motor oil, and items with freon are not accepted. ***
